I would like to offer our congratulations on the improvements to your school's achievement outcomes in 2015.

It is very positive to see that Key Stage 2 results for Level 4+ reading, writing and mathematics combined have improved significantly from 78% to 89%.

It is also good to see that outcomes for Level 5+ have shown an improvement with 26% for 2015 compared to 22% in 2014.

Pupils' progress is high with results for 2015 showing that 96% of children made 2 Levels of Progress in reading and 100% in mathematics compared with 88% and 85% respectively in 2014.

I would also particularly like to highlight your success in closing the achievement gap for disadvantaged pupils with 100% of children in receipt of Pupil Premium attaining Level 4+ reading, writing and mathematics combined.

As a one form entry school, every member of staff should feel they have contributed to these outcomes, which I am confident are due to a whole school and community effort as well as your effective leadership.

My team and I look forward to working with you, your staff and Governing Body to ensure these encouraging results are sustained during 2015 and beyond.
