In Maths this week the children have working hard on number bonds to 10. The children have been using the numicon to help them visualise these numbers bonds. We have also been thinking about writing our numbers the correct way round.

In English we have been thinking about the story of Little Red Riding Hood. The children were able to retell the story in class to each other and were able to sequence some sentences from the story. The children thought about the characters in the story and wrote a descriptive sentence for each.

In Phonics we have been continuing to revise the alphabet letter names and all of the letter sounds from Imps. We have been thinking about the sounds oo, or and ar. We have also been learning to spell the tricky words no and go.

In Science this week we have had a little break from our topic of Materials to think about **Seasonal Change**, especially now that we are well and truly in Autumn! Over the weekend or half term perhaps you'd like to see what Autumn treasures you can find!
