Assembly

This morning in celebration assembly we celebrated Isabelle for taking part in discussions and answering questions about all of our learning and Freddie for telling us the differences in two maths pictures, using the word "angle".



Reading – all the Pixies should have brought home a Big Cat Phonics reading book. Please send in reading books and Monkey reading record books every day. Please keep practising with your Pixie at home as it really does make a big difference in school.

Maths – Pixies have been sorting objects into groups and explaining why they sorted them in the way that they did. In Mastering number, they have been finding all the ways to make 5, using the dice frames and Rekenreks.

English – The Pixies have started our Power of Reading book The Story Tree. They have listened to two stories from the book so far and will be thinking about one of the stories in their writing over the next week.

Phonics – We have started our Autumn 1 Unit which recaps the graphemes and phonemes from Reception Summer term.

Please help your Pixie to write and spell their name correctly as there are lots of occasions when they need to write their name independently in Year 1.

For term 1 – the Pixies are having a little bit of their own learning time in the afternoons.
