Assembly

Reading - The Pixies should have brought home a new phonics based book. Thank you for continuing to practise reading. Your Pixie should be fluent on the reading book by the time it comes home. You can challenge them by asking them to point out digraphs and tricky words like he, she and the. You can do the same when sharing other books and this will help with word recognition and their progress in reading.

Science - We have sourced objects from around the school, named them and identified what they are made of. Perhaps you could have a discussion about materials found around your house?

Maths - Pixies have been adding two numbers to make five and also finding five inside bigger numbers.

English - The Pixies visualised the story The Sweetest Song, made a role on the wall about Little Daughter and started a story map.

Art - The Pixies looked at the art of Corey Barksdale and thought about what certain artworks reminded them of.

Geography - We learnt what the four countries in the UK are called and that the UK is in the continent of Europe. We learnt a song about the names of the seven continents but it is tricky to remember them all.
