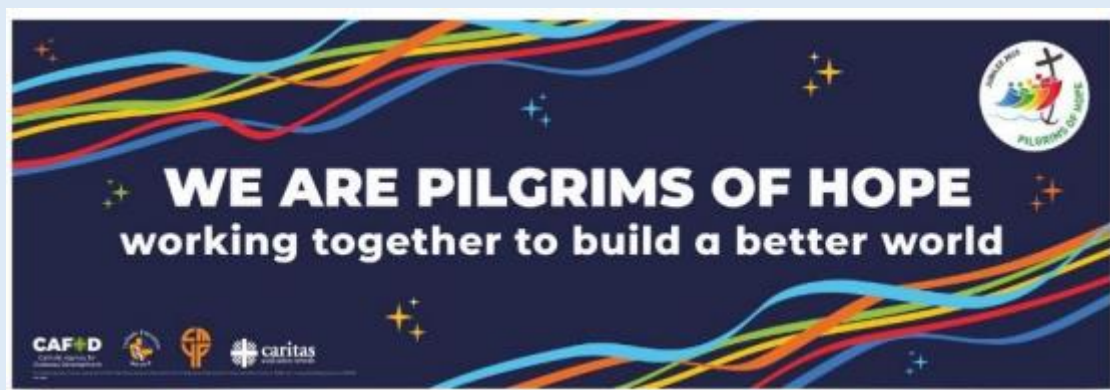


Unicorns Newsletter – Friday 4th September 2026
