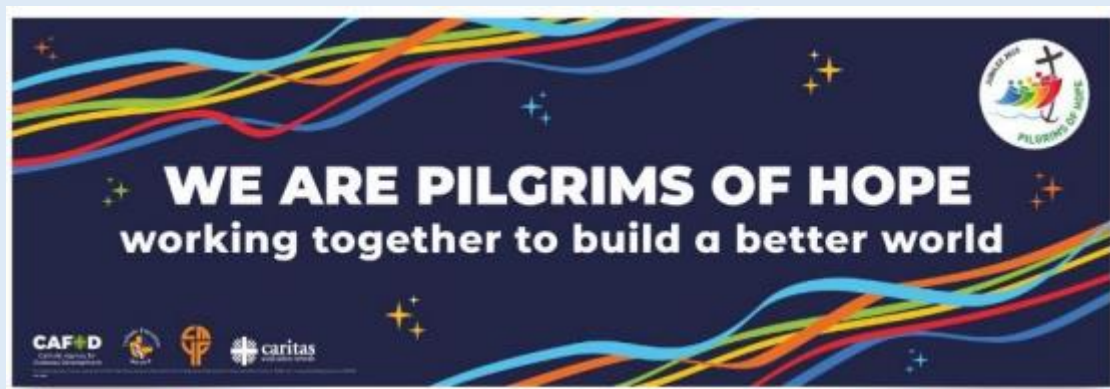


Unicorns Newsletter – Friday 11th September 2026
