Please complete at least one task each week as well as learning your weekly spellings. There is an award for all children who complete at least six pieces each term.

History: Can you interview a grown up (an older family member, friend or neighbour) about their favourite toy when they were a child? What was their favourite toy? When was it made? Think of some more interview questions that you could ask. Record your interview in any way you like - ask a grown up to help with this. 	Maths: Set up your own toyshop at home! Give some of your toys price tags. Take turns to be the shopkeeper and customer. Buy an item and find the correct coins needed to pay. Can you buy more than one item and add to find the total? 	Computing: Can you design a poster that explains the importance of staying safe online? 
English: Write an advert / leaflet for a toy. Make it eye catching and include information about the toy. Write a description of the toy, what it does and why people should buy it. See what adjectives and expanded noun phrases you can use in your writing. 	Design and Technology: Design and build a 3D model of a toy. You could use junk modelling or construction to make your toy. Can you include a moving part? You can bring in your model or take a photograph to share with everyone.	RE: Let us fill the classroom with love. Can you design and decorate a love heart that we can display in the classroom? 
Science: <i>Everyday Materials</i> Can you draw one of your favourite toys from home? Label your drawing carefully with the materials used to make it. 	An idea of your own! You can get creative and think of anything you would like to do based on what you have been learning about in school! 	Prayer: Can you write a prayer about new beginnings?
